## NEXT EA PAY INCREASE

Your next pay increase under your Enterprise Agreement will take effect from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> May 2016. Your pay will be increased by a further 1.965%. This means that your pay slip for the pay period ending 12<sup>th</sup> June should be the first to reflect this increase.

As your Union subscriptions are set at 1% of the Leading Firefighter salary, the increase in your salary will correspond with a small increase in your subscription rate as well. Don't forget that your Union fees are tax deductible and a statement of subscriptions you pay each year is available from the Union office on request.

In accordance with clause 5.8.2 of your Enterprise Agreement, all salary-related expenses, excluding allowances adjusted by the Australian Tax Office, will be adjusted by 3.93% reflecting your salary increases for the last year of your Agreement [May 2016-May 2017].

Should Airservices not have adjusted your salary rates in time for payment in the pay period ending 12<sup>th</sup> June your salary increase will still be backdated to and paid from 30<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
