IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR MEMBERS

PIA Ballot Action Item 7

Limiting or Banning Higher Duties

The Fair Work Commission has ordered that 7 clear business days' notice must be given for this particular action to allow Airservices sufficient time to make other preparations.

All Members

From 0001 13 May 2022 this action, by limiting some higher duties will be protected by BANNING RELIEF TO THE LINE LEADER FOR CALL OUT CONTINGENCY (COC). Of course, in case of emergency (which is an imminent and serious risk to life/environment/property), any member who may be available can still respond.

Health and Safety

As PIA continues if you have any concerns, you should raise these with your Crew's Bans Committee Member, Health and Safety Representative, Workplace Delegate or Branch Committee Member.

Stay informed

Updates on additional PIA actions will follow in due course. To date and including this update, 7 PIA Actions have been sanctioned and announced by the Branch Committee of Management.
