Yesterday the Union bargaining team met with the Airservices bargaining team.

Summary of discussion

Wages

Airservices still won't budge until the government's new industrial relations policies are released. This also holds up negotiations on any other monetary items: superannuation contributions and allowances.

Transfers

We are still awaiting Airservices as they are in discussions with "other areas of the business".

Staffing

The Union seeks a clause that recognises ICAO's Task Resource Analysis as the appropriate methodology to determine minimum staffing and that employee representatives should be fully consulted in its development. Given the status of staffing around the country, the relevance of a staffing clause couldn't be higher.

Remote Locality Allowance / 2018 Deed

Spirited discussions were had about the localities of Proserpine and Hamilton Island.

Next steps

The Secretary and President will shortly meet with the Chief Service Delivery Officer, following this the Branch Committee of Management will consider future actions of Protected Industrial Action.
